Bangladesh's Austerity Budget 2025-26 – A Cautious Step Toward Economic Stability

Bangladesh's national budget for fiscal year 2025-26, approved on June 22, 2025, has been described as an "austerity budget". For the first time in history, the total allocation is smaller than the previous year, reflecting the government's focus on economic stability amid high inflation and financial uncertainty.

Positives at a Glance

- Prudent Spending: Total budget of Tk 7,90,000 crore, with the Annual Development Programme (ADP) reduced to Tk 2,30,000 crore, emphasizes efficiency and targeted development projects.
- Realistic Targets: GDP growth projected at 5.5% and inflation at 6.5%, aligning with current economic conditions.
- Social Protection: Allocation for social safety nets increased to Tk 91,297 crore, providing relief to vulnerable populations.
- Tax Relief: Personal income tax-free threshold raised to Tk 3.75 lakh, with special provisions for the "July Warriors" injured in the July 2024 uprising.

Criticisms and Concerns

- Limited Investment Focus: The budget lacks a clear roadmap for job creation and long-term investment, which are crucial for sustainable growth.
- Regressive Tax Measures: VAT increases on consumer goods, including plastic tableware, could disproportionately affect lower- and middle-income households.
- Revenue Challenges: Ambitious revenue targets may be difficult to achieve without fundamental tax reforms, raising concerns about fiscal sustainability.
- Dependence on Bank Borrowing: Part of the deficit will be financed through bank borrowing, which could increase financial sector risks and affect fiscal sustainability.
- Balancing Social Welfare and Fiscal Prudence: While allocations for social safety nets have increased, maintaining this balance alongside deficit reduction is a persistent challenge.

- **Economic Uncertainty:** Global and domestic pressures, such as inflationary trends, currency volatility and external shocks pose risks to budget implementation.

The 2025-26 budget is a cautious but necessary step toward stabilizing Bangladesh's economy. It balances fiscal restraint with social responsibility, offering realistic targets and support for vulnerable groups. However, without bold strategies for investment, employment and structural growth, the country risks limited long-term economic transformation.

Ensuring Rigorous Implementation of the Academic Calendar

The European University of Bangladesh (EUB) offers 19 academic programs across 11 departments, with all courses carefully scheduled in the University's annual Academic Calendar. EUB has consistently demonstrated strict adherence to the Academic Calendar, reflecting its unwavering commitment to academic excellence, operational efficiency, and institutional integrity.

The Summer 2025 Semester (May–August 2025) concluded successfully, with 17,141 classes scheduled across all programs. Of these, 16,865 classes were conducted as planned, achieving a completion rate of 98.39%. This exemplary performance underscores the University's dedication to delivering high-quality education and maintaining rigorous academic discipline.

To ensure seamless coordination, EUB has established a Program Coordination Unit (PCU), which serves as a central interface between students and faculty. The PCU monitors adherence to schedules, promotes effective time management, and ensures that academic objectives are consistently achieved.
