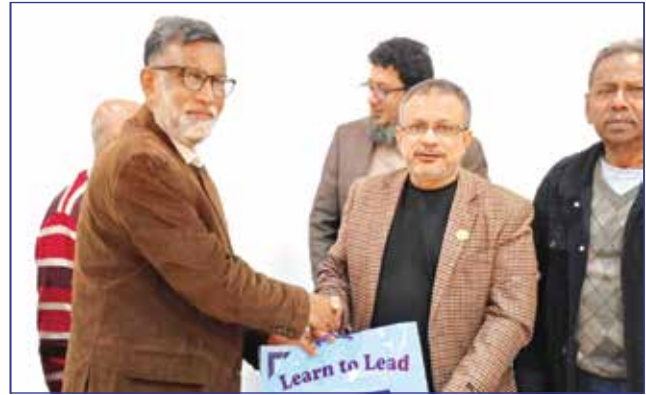

As a part of EUB's initiatives to connect EUB with credible Partnership Programme with Foreign Universities, a productive discussion was held on 5 January 2026 at Department of Business Administration, European University of Bangladesh (EUB) with representatives from the University of the West of Scotland (UWS) London and Vive Education Group to explore a potential MoU with the Department of Business Administration.

The meeting was conducted under the supervision of



the EUB Business and Career Development Club and was graced by the presence of EUB's Vice Chancellor, Registrar, Advisor of Student Welfare, respected faculty members, Club moderator and Members and the Chairperson of the Department of Business Administration.

If finalized, the agreement will offer up to 40% scholarship along with an exclusive additional USD 1,000 redemption scholarship for EUB students.

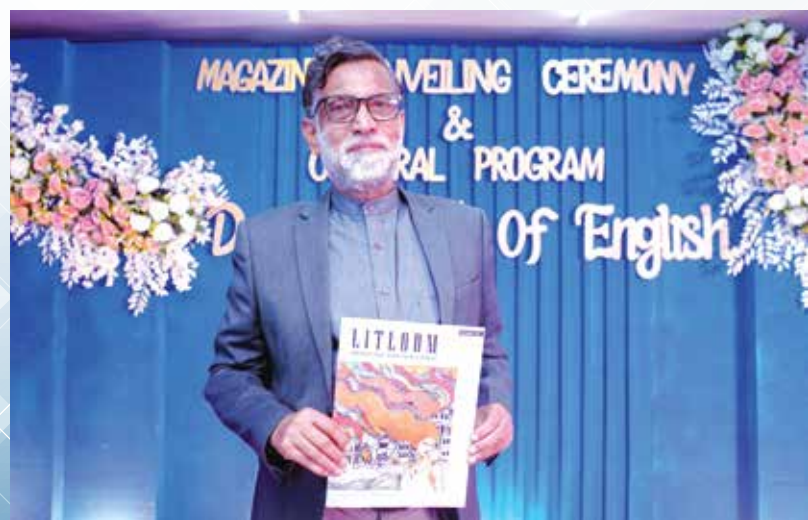
