Feature Article

Building the Future of EUB From Aspiration to Achievement

I. Introduction

The European University of Bangladesh (EUB) carries an important responsibility: to meet national standards set by the Bangladesh Accreditation Council (BAC) while also aligning with global benchmarks of higher education. Quality is not just about infrastructure—it comes from motivated faculty, engaged students, effective teaching, strong governance and opportunities that prepare students for meaningful careers. EUB's mission is "to provide affordable higher education that meets current and future social needs, enabling students to achieve academic excellence, personal growth and career success in a supportive environment." This paper presents EUB's vision for quality, both in the short term (0-2 years) and long term (3-7 years) and the strategies to realize it.

II. Foundational Milestones (0-2 Years)

The first phase focuses on establishing a solid foundation for quality, credibility and effective institutional functioning. Key priorities include:

A. Accreditation and Internal Quality Assurance:

All programs will comply with BAC standards, supported by a strengthened Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), faculty development, curriculum review and necessary infrastructure upgrades.

B. Improving Teaching and Learning

EUB aims to adopt internationally recognized teaching practices, including Checkering and Gamson's Seven Principles for Good Practice, through workshops, peer observation and modern teaching tools to make learning more effective and engaging.

C. Faculty and Staff Motivation

Competitive salaries, benefits, research grants and recognition of diverse scholarly contributions are essential to attract and retain talented faculty, drawing inspiration from leading institutions such as Independent University, Bangladesh (IUB).

D. Student Admission and Quality Control

Merit-based admission tests, scholarships and remedial courses in English, mathematics and IT will help ensure that students are well-prepared to succeed.

E. Dropout Prevention

EUB will prioritize orientation programs, mentorship, academic advising and financial support to retain students and foster social and academic integration, especially during the crucial first year.

III. Strategic Horizon (3-7 Years)

In the longer term, EUB aims for full BAC accreditation and

alignment with international quality frameworks such as the ESG, while fostering global partnerships. Key strategies include:

- **Research and Innovation:** Establishing research centers, providing grants, publishing work and collaborating with industry to create a culture of inquiry and innovation, following the example of BRAC University.
- **Employability:** Strengthening career services, linking curricula to industry needs and developing students' soft skills.
- **Faculty Support:** Maintaining faculty motivation through updated salaries, research assistance and advanced teaching resources.
- **Transparent Governance:** Using tools like the Balanced Scorecard to ensure accountability, trust and good governance.

IV. Conclusion

In the short term, EUB's priorities are accreditation, teaching quality, faculty motivation and student retention. In the long term, the focus shifts to global recognition, strong research, high employability and transparent governance. By combining competitive incentives, comprehensive student support and adherence to international standards, EUB can achieve sustainable excellence and emerge as a leading institution both nationally and globally—creating opportunities that positively impact students, the community and society at large.
